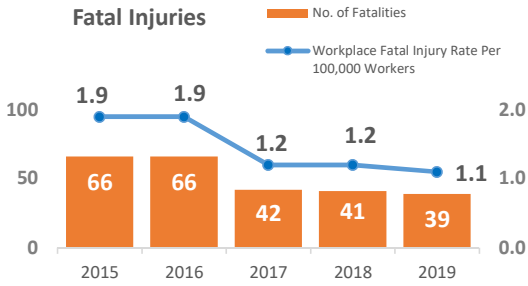

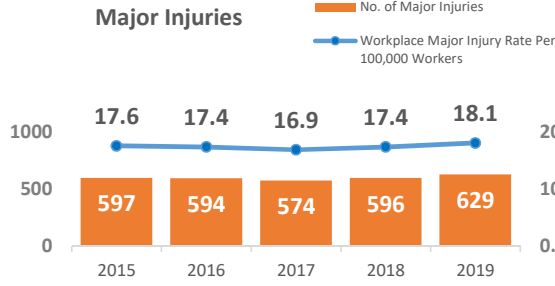
Workplace fatal injury rate reduced to 1.1 per 100,000 workers in 2019; but numbers and rates of major and minor injuries continued to increase



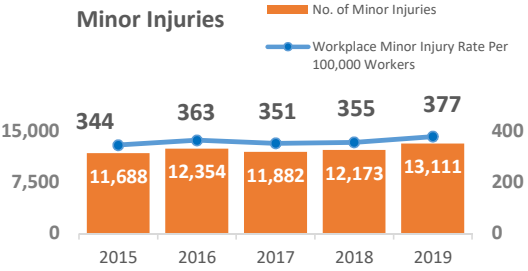
Fatal Injuries



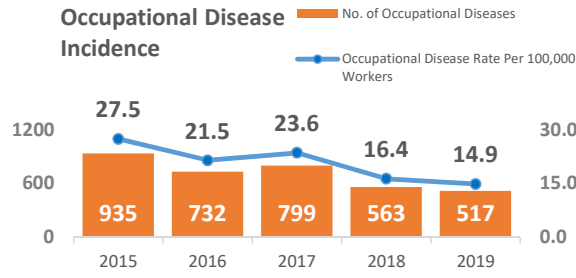
Major Injuries



Minor Injuries



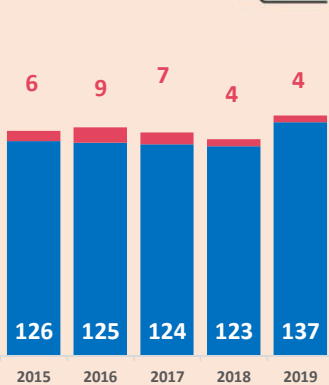
Occupational Disease Incidence



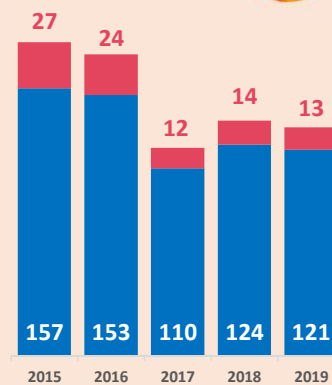
Marginally fewer fatal and major injuries in Construction; but more in the Manufacturing, Transportation & Storage, and Accommodation & Food Services industries

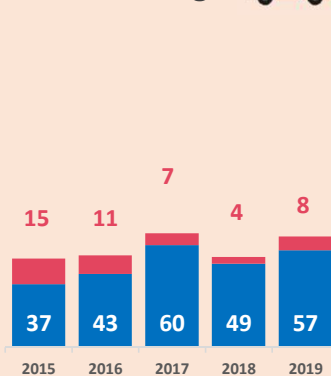

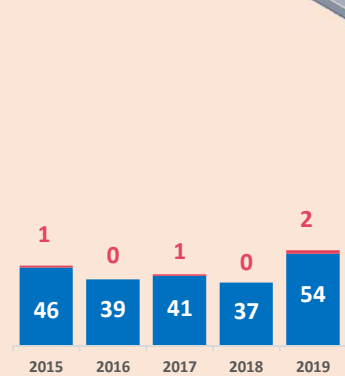
Construction

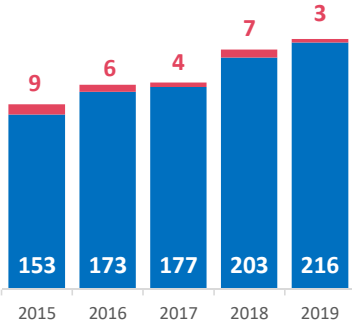

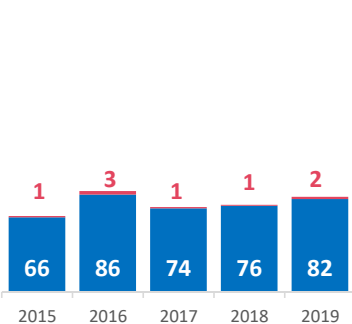
Slips, Trips & Falls and Machinery Incidents continued to increase

- Fatalities

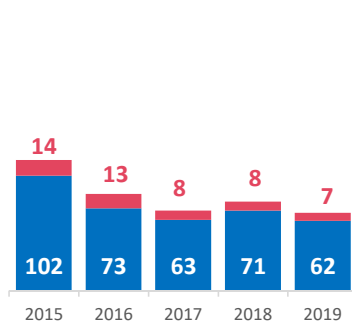
Falls - Slips, Trips & Falls



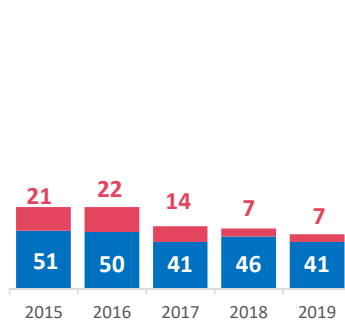
Machinery Incidents
