

COVID-19 Vaccination for Migrant Domestic Workers

When can I be vaccinated?

- Migrant domestic workers (MDWs) who are above 45 years old can register and receive their COVID-19 vaccination.
- From later half of May 2021,
 MDWs below 45 years old can
 register their interest and you will
 be invited when eligible, according
 to the prevailing age bands.

Why should I go for COVID-19 vaccination?

Vaccination can:

- Prevent COVID-19 and minimise transmission.
- Enable us to resume more activities safely.
- Prevent our healthcare system from being overwhelmed.
- Protect yourself and those who cannot be vaccinated due to medical reasons.

Can I be vaccinated?

COVID-19 vaccines are suitable for persons with:

- Chronic conditions

 (e.g. hypertensions, diabetics, high cholesterol, heart disease)
- Non-severe allergic reactions to medication, food or insect bites
- Have eczema or asthma

How can I register for the COVID-19 vaccination?
