

COVID-19 Vaccination for Migrant Domestic Workers

When can I be vaccinated?

>45

Migrant domestic workers (MDWs) who are above 45 years old can register and receive their COVID-19 vaccination.

From later half of May 2021, MDWs below 45 years old can register their interest and you will be invited when eligible, according to the prevailing age bands.

Can I be vaccinated?

COVID-19 vaccines are suitable for persons with:

- ✓ Chronic conditions (e.g. hypertension, diabetes, high cholesterol, heart disease)
- ✓ Non-severe allergic reactions to medication, food or insect bites
- ✓ Have eczema or asthma

Why should I go for COVID-19 vaccination?

Vaccination can:

- 👍 Prevent COVID-19 and minimise transmission.
- 👍 Enable us to resume more activities safely.
- 👍 Prevent our healthcare system from being overwhelmed.
- 👍 Protect yourself and those who cannot be vaccinated due to medical reasons.
